CONFINED SPACE GRAIN BIN ENTRY

The Grain Safety program is intended for workers and managers in the grain industry. This includes grain elevators, farm operators and workers, grain haulers, and agriculture business owners. The major focus of the program is on safety in confined space work areas including entry, respiratory protection, and prevention of grain dust explosions. space entry and lock out procedures.

UNDERSTANDING AGRICULTURAL RESPIRATORY HAZARDS AND RESPIRATOR SELECTION

The goal of the training is to inform agricultural producers and employers of agricultural workers about agricultural respiratory exposures and diseases that are common in the agricultural environment. The course will cover respiratory hazards associated with agricultural exposure with an emphasis on selecting the correct respirator.

RESPIRATORY PROTECTION PROGRAM ADAPTED TO GRAIN HANDLING OPERATIONS

This training will assist agriculture-based employers who require respirator use to comply with the OSHA respiratory protection program standard. Training includes written worksite specific procedures, program evaluation, selection of an appropriate respirator approved by NIOSH, training, fit testing, inspection, cleaning, maintenance, and storage, medical evaluation, work area surveillance and air quality standards.
